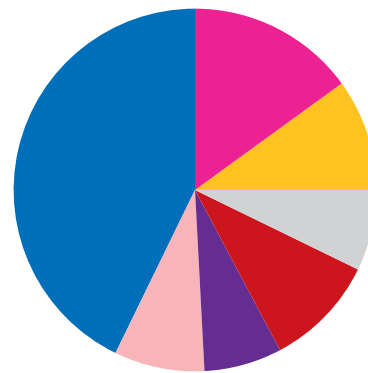

### GA-10

**exports \$539 million**  
 in goods to Canada annually

#### Top GA-10 goods exports to Canada

- Agricultural & construction machinery..... \$76 million
- Engines & turbines..... \$41 million
- Resins & Synthetic Fibers.....\$39 million
- Plastics Products..... \$37 million
- HVAC & Refrigeration Equipment.....\$28 million



#### GA-10 goods exports by industry

- Agriculture (10%)
- Chemicals (15%)
- Equipment & machinery (43%)
- Minerals & metals (8%)
- Plastics & rubbers (7%)
- Transportation (10%)
- Other (7%)

- Insurance services..... \$2 million
